



## Summer Fellowship Program 2018

The NBR Fellowship Program aims to combine a student's community engagement with their academic and career goals. NBR Fellows are committed to working in a sustained, intentional, and intensive way that works to address issues in one of our four focus areas: Clean and Safe Environments, Marketing and Communications, Maintenance and Landscaping and Economic Development. Together with community partners, Fellows will strive to build stronger communities where people have the resources they need to reach their full potential.

We support students of diverse economic and social backgrounds. The goal is for them to become active participants in society through their community engagement. To accomplish this the NBR provides reflection and skill development opportunities, mentorship and advising, and financial assistance for fellows accepted into the program.

### NBR Fellows must commit to:

- Participate in the program from June 27 – August 10.
- The program takes place Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Participate in a weekly 2-hour leadership development block.
- Community outreach and projects that involve being outdoors for extended periods of time.

### NBR Fellows who fulfill these commitments receive:

- Structured mentorship and leadership skill-building in socially just, community-based work
- A minimum of a \$1000 stipend (paid after successfully completing the summer fellowship) and transportation assistance.

### Who is eligible to apply?

We seek to develop a diverse team of students with a broad range of interests and passions, who desire to engage in community work. For the 2018 fellowship, we will recruit ten (10) incoming NBR Community Fellows. We are especially interested in students who are first-generation college students, from low-income households, and/or have demonstrated a passion for community engagement. Fellows must be high school seniors or at least 18 years of age.
